**Clara Biswas, Outreach Missionary. Street Children Ministry** is an arm of the Methodist Mission in Cambodia run by General Board of Global Ministries missionaries. Since 2001, the Ministry has been working in slums near the Tonle Bassac river, Daem Kor village, & the community living off the city Dumpsite. In 2007, they expanded to work in New Phnom Penh. Their vision is to help create a world where marginalized people experience the love of God, love God, and are given opportunities to develop vocational skills and help them grow in Christ. Their mission is to share the Gospel and love of God by funding children's education, teaching vocational skills, and providing health care to the sick and undernourished. They strive to give hope to the hopeless, shine light to those in darkness, bring Christ to the poor, and share the love of God with all.

**Lincoln Park Community Shelter.** LPCS brings communities together to empower individuals facing homelessness and poverty to secure stable housing and make sustainable life changes. LPCS staff, Guests, volunteers, stakeholders, and donors are a micro-community with common interests and goals that hold each responsible to the other. Together, they work within Lincoln Park Community Services and with the larger community to ensure members receive the support, respect, and understanding they need to empower their lives.
