The cooperative **Native American Ministry of Presence** works with the Kateri Center Roman Catholic Native American Ministries, and the American Indian Center of Chicago to assist in planning program and cultural events that continue to celebrate traditional values, language, music and Native American spirituality. We also provide opportunities to learn about Jesus through worship services, family camp, Tipi camp, Bible study, talking circles and assisting in the development and training of the laity by attending conference and jurisdictional training events specifically developed for Native Americans.

Masjid al-Rabia is an Islamic community center in Chicago providing inclusive, affirming Muslim community while fostering in an Islam that leaves no one behind. What does that look like? Some of the things Masjid al-Rabia provides: We host jummah prayers every Friday. We have a library of Qur'ans and critical Islamic texts free for anyone to borrow. We host regular social events for Muslims and allies who want to get involved. We educate and advocate on behalf of women, queer & trans people, and other marginalized Muslims.
