November Mission Minute: The REDress Project. Thank you for your support of the REDress Project! It is a stunning visual reminder of the indigenous women that have been lost to violence. The color red is the official color of MMIWG (Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women and Girls) because the color draws attention forcing us to face the injustice. Also, in some cultures, it is believed that spirits can only see the color red, so the dresses guide the spirits of those lost back to their families. Jamie Black, the creator of the REDress Project states "Indigenous women face higher rates of violence than any other cultural group in Canada and the United States. Indigenous families and communities have been advocating for generations to make changes to the colonial system that often treat the perpetrators of this violence with impunity. The REDress Project works to create space for families of Murdered and Missing Indigenous Persons (MMIP) and their supporters to tell their stories and to find solidarity in the struggle to protect the rights of Indigenous women and girls. The project provides a space to hear from frontline community workers, Indigenous women academics, elders and knowledge keepers on how we can work together as a community to bring justice to Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women and Girls (MMIWG) and their families."
